READ ALONG WITH US

As a church family, we are reading through the New Testament together in 2025! God's Word is life and it changes us from the inside out! As you commit to following this reading plan, take it one day at a time.

This reading plan is created to run from Monday through Friday, giving you the weekends to catch up on anything you've missed.

STEPS FOR SUCCESS:

- **1. PLAN -** Prioritize your Bible reading each morning, or whatever time works best for you.
- 2. PACE We are focusing on taking our time and not rushing through the Scripture. Soak in each chapter, and if you have extra time, read the chapter over again.

3. PLACE - Create a quiet space for reading with your Bible, pen, and notebook, and be ready to begin.

4. PRAY -

Ask God to give you a love for Him and His Word that is stronger than anything else!

5. PARTNER - Ask a friend to do the reading plan with you as well, and to be your accountability partner. Check in with your friend each week and be honest with each other about where you are.

*Focus not just on information, but transformation.

QUESTION BIBLE STUDY METHOD

As you read the Bible, it is important to learn where to begin with your alone time with God. Below are seven simple questions to ask yourself, as you study the Bible and apply it to your life.

- 1. What did I learn about God?
- 2. What did I learn about people?
- 3. Is there a sin to avoid?
- 4. Is there a promise to claim?
- 5. Is there an example to follow?
- 6. Is there a command to obey?
- 7. How do we see Jesus in this passage?

JOHN 3:16-21

(Here is an example of the Question Method in the book of John)

What did I learn about God?

- God loves the world. (vs. 16)
 - God sent His Son to die for us because of His deep love for us. (vs. 16)

What did I learn about people?

- People loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. (vs. 19)
 - Whoever does what is true comes to the light. (vs. 21)

Is there a sin to avoid?

It is a sin to love the darkness rather than the light.
 (vs. 20)

Is there a promise to claim?

- Whoever believes in the Son will not perish, but have eternal life. (vs. 16)
 - God sent His Son so that we could be saved through Him. (vs. 17)

Is there an example to follow?

- Obey the truth and come to the light. (vs. 21)

Is there a command to obey?

 Do not be condemned. Believe in Jesus and have eternal life. (vs. 16-17)

How do we see Jesus in this passage?

- Jesus is having a one-on-one conversation with Nicodemus.

*You may not be able to answer every question in every passage.

S.O.A.P. BIBLE STUDY METHOD



The S.O.A.P. Bible Study Method is one way to go deeper into your Scripture reading. S.O.A.P. stands for: Scripture, Observation, Application, and Prayer.

Scripture

Read a Scripture passage. Which verses in the passage stood out to you the most? What phrases impacted you? Write out specific verses, passages, or phrases from the Scripture that spoke to you.

Observation

What did you observe in this passage of Scripture? Are there any warnings, principles, or commands? What is the overall message of this passage of Scripture?

Application

Look for ways that you can apply what you have read in the Bible. How do these verses apply to your life today? How can you live differently in light of these truths? Are there areas of your life that do not align with these verses? What action steps can you take to obey God's Word?

Prayer

Turn these Scripture verses and truths into a prayer. Ask the Lord to help you live out these Scriptures and to apply them to your life. Praise Him for His truth and how He is using His Word to renew your mind and grow you to love and know Him.

A.C.T.S. PRAYER ACRONYM



ADORATION

Adore God by praising who He is. "God, You are good, glorious, faithful, and loving."



CONFESSION

Confess your sins to God and ask for His forgiveness. "God, I ask for Your forgiveness for my sins."



THANKSGIVING

Thank God for all the good things He has done and will do. "God, I am thankful for the ways You have moved in my life."



SUPPLICATION

Bring your prayer requests before God. "God, please help me..."
